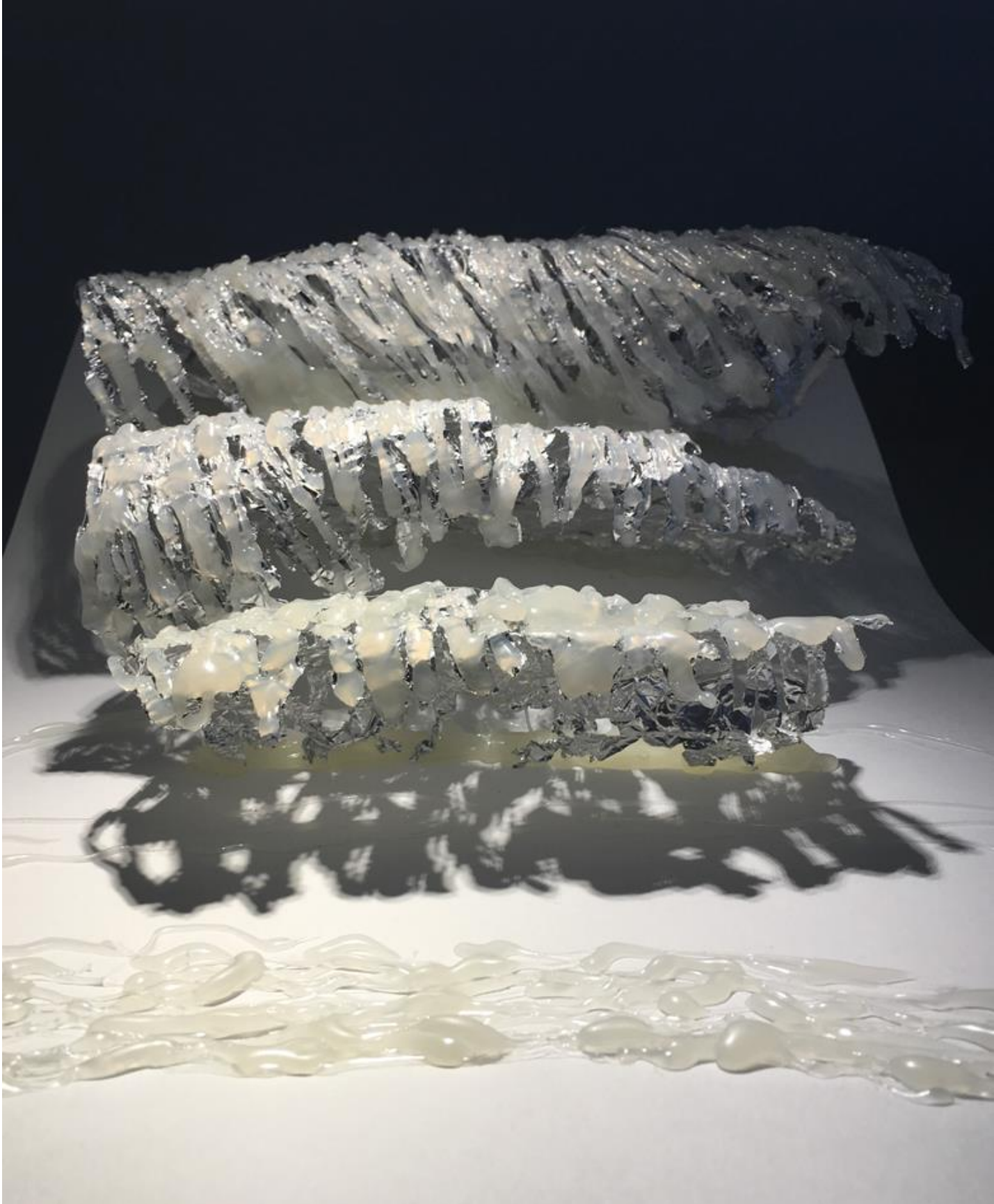
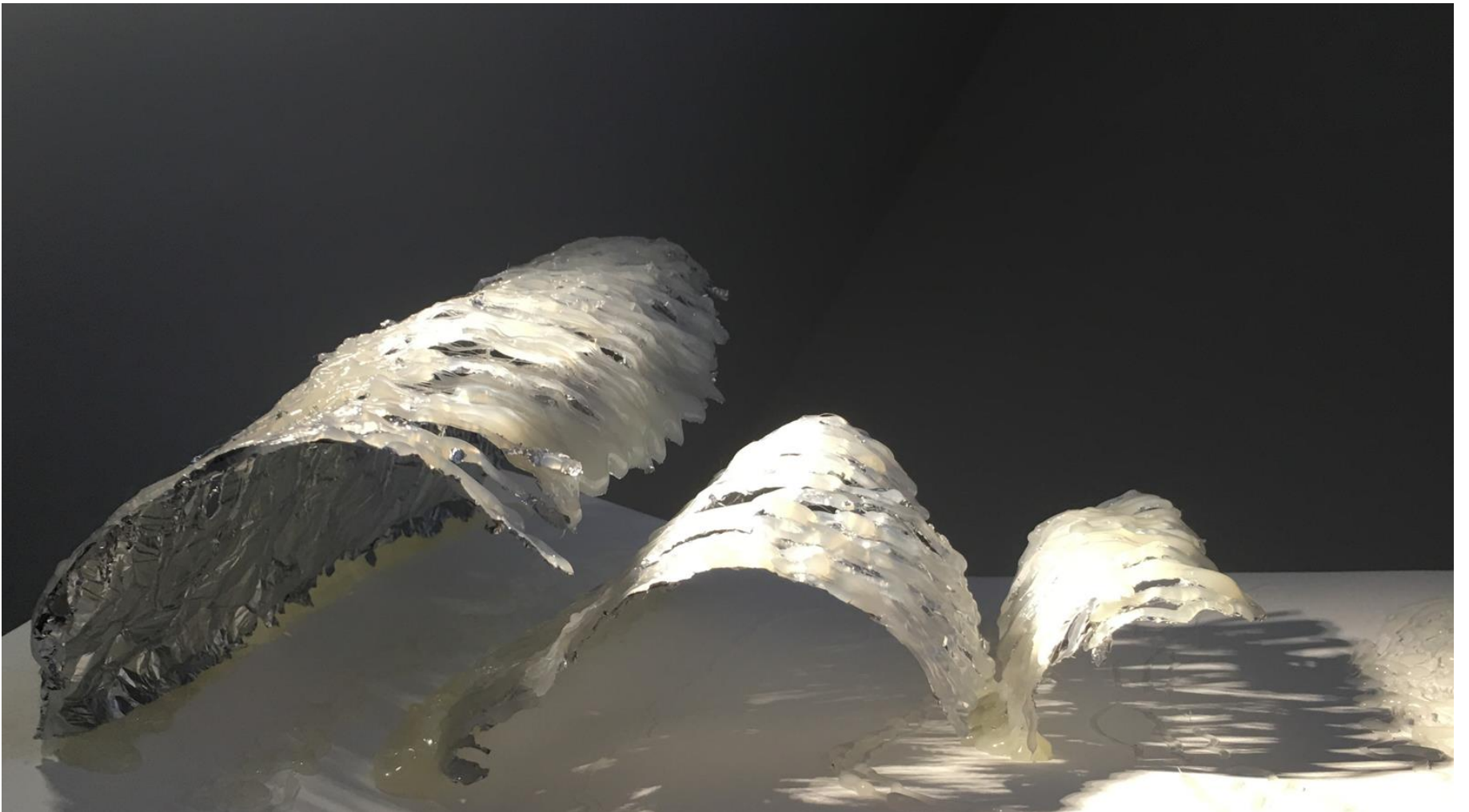

This is a sculpture of three waves which cast shadows. The three waves represent the generations of a family. The sculpture shows how the waves all flow in the same direction but ultimately end up a mere shadow before the wave breaks and disappears. Yet we know that the spirit of the last wave remains with us forever, and that the cycle of life continues to ebb and flow.

The sculpture was made out of glue from a glue gun. I randomly poured the glue on to kitchen foil and when dry I cut away the foil where there was no glue which created these small gaps. I then manipulated the foil to create the waves. Each wave is unique just like a human being.

All the way through the Pandemic I keep hearing that we are in the first wave, then the second wave etc. But at the same time we are saying our farewells to people who have lost their fight against COVID. The wave has become symbolic of fear and death.
